



# ENROLLMENT FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **Session dates and locations:**

Cowan: June 11 - 15 and July 16 - 20. El Reno: June 18 - 22 and July 9 - 13.

## **Cost?**

The cost is \$80 per SESSION. (Morning = \$80, Afternoon = \$80, Full day at Cowan = \$160)

## **What are the times of the sessions?**

Morning sessions run 8:30am - 11:30am. Afternoon sessions run 12:30pm - 3:30pm.

## **Do you have a full day option?**

This year we are offering morning (8:30 - 11:30) and afternoon (12:30 - 3:30) sessions at our Cowan campus during the weeks of June 11 - 15 and July 16 - 20. This option is not offered during the weeks at El Reno.

## **Will Lunch be provided?**

No, if your child is enrolled in both a morning and afternoon session, please send a packed lunch. However, a snack will be provided during each session.

## **Does my student have to go to both sessions?**

No, you may enroll your child for any and all sessions you choose.

## **Is there an age limit?**

Tech Quest is open to students entering 5th - 9th grades in the upcoming school year. Two courses are limited beyond that. **Diesel Engines** and **Metal Working** are only open to 7th - 9th grades for safety reasons.

## **Do I need to provide any supplies?**

Crafting - Boho Chic: students will need to bring a t-shirt they would like to turn into a bag. No other courses require supplies from home, unless discussed by the instructor during the course of the camp.

## **Are there any discounts?**

We do not offer any discounts. (Employees, teachers, siblings, multiple sessions, etc.)

## **Dress code requirement?**

Please follow the dress code of your school. Closed toed shoes are required for Diesel Engines, Metal Working, Wood Working, Automotive Refinishing Basics, Game On!, Fun with Gardening, Outdoor Education, and Strength in Motion.

## **Do you have after-camp care?**

No, our camps end at 3:30 each day, and students need to be picked up accordingly.

## **Friday Showcase**

Each Friday parents/family members are invited to tour our campus and join your student(s) in their courses to view their projects for the week. Tours will begin at 8:45 (AM session) and 12:45 (PM session), classes open at 10:00 (AM session) and 2:00 (PM session).

## **Transportation:**

You can drop your student off at the location of their camp OR buses will run from each campus to the other. You may drop your student off at the camp most convenient for you and they will ride the bus to the location of their camp course. Our bus will return them to the location they were picked up from originally for your convenience. Buses will leave at 8:15am for morning session and 12:15pm for afternoon session and travel to the opposite campus.

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### **Location and times:**

This year, Parent Quest is only offered at our El Reno campus, Monday - Thursday, during the weeks of June 18 - 22 and July 9 - 13. Parent Quest courses will run from 8:30am - 11:30am each morning, coinciding with Tech Quest. (Not offered on Fridays due to Tech Quest Friday Showcase.)
