MORE INFORMATION ON ENROLLING

Adult applications are accepted year-round. Students MUST submit a required waiver (and the Next Step application if you are 18-23 and want to be considered for the tuition waiver.) Enrollment is subject to availability; most of our programs have waitlists. Career counselors (For More Information tab) can answer specific questions on enrollment timelines. High school freshman-junior applicants are only accepted during the fall when the application link is open.
